



For Hall of Justice Visitors

Welcome to the Michigan Hall of Justice. To ensure the best possible experience for our visitors, and to safeguard the justice process, we ask you to please observe the following:

Out of courtesy for the Court and attorneys at Supreme Court hearings, those in the courtroom audience should remain quiet and avoid disrupting the proceedings. Cell phones and pagers must be turned off or placed on "silent" or "vibrate" mode.

Please do not move around the courtroom or repeatedly exit and enter. Food or beverages are not allowed in the courtroom, but are permitted in the conference center on the first floor.

Audio recording and still or video photography are not permitted in the courtroom except for media, and then only by prior arrangement and permission from the Court.

The Court has discretion to admonish, and order the removal of, anyone who disrupts courtroom proceedings or does not comply with Hall of Justice policy.

Distribution of printed material, such as brochures and flyers, is prohibited both in the courtroom and in the Hall of Justice. Signs, banners, and other displays are also prohibited in the courtroom and elsewhere in the Hall of Justice.
