Michigan Supreme Court**

Video Resource & Discussion Guide

Description

The Michigan Supreme Court Learning Center, a unit of the Michigan Judicial Institute, has created a video resource and companion discussion guide that examines the role of oral arguments in the appellate process of the Michigan Supreme Court. The resource uses *Wayne County v Hathcock* 471 Mich 445 (2004) as a case study. The video resource is available in DVD or VHS format; the discussion guide may be downloaded from the Learning Center's web site, <http://courts.mi.gov/plc/>.

Distribution Policy

For those requesting the DVD format, one copy will be mailed free of charge. However, the number of copies in VHS format is limited. Videotapes are loaned for a period of up to **30 days**. An additional extension of 7 days will be granted if no other request is pending, and the Learning Center has been contacted prior to the original due date. A replacement fee of \$30 is charged for non-returned, damaged, or lost videotapes. If the videotape is returned in good condition, charges are waived.
