



Muskegon County's 60th District Court offers amnesty this week for people who owe money

MUSKEGON COUNTY — People who have overdue fines and costs owed to Muskegon County's 60th District Court have until Friday to pay them without penalty.

The court is conducting an amnesty this week. For those who pay their fines and costs in person, by mail or credit card during the last week of April, district court will waive the 20 percent late fee.

The amnesty program extends to those who are wanted on bench warrants for failing to pay fines and costs. The court says those people will not be arrested if they take care of their outstanding fines and costs in full this week.

The amnesty program runs daily 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. through Friday.
