

## **District Court Offers Amnesty Those owing fees can pay up and not be incarcerated**

CHEBOYGAN - Call it amnesty, or call it safe surrender.

Either way, the bottom line is that anyone with unfinished court business can come clean in August without further penalty.

The Cheboygan County 89th District Court is offering a chance for anyone with an open warrant for failing to pay fines, costs, and fees or has an outstanding debt in the criminal or traffic divisions of the court to make things right.

The guarantee from the court is that those who turn themselves in will not be incarcerated for their outstanding debt with the Court.

The offer is effective from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday during the month of August at the 89th District Court, 870 South Main St. in Cheboygan. The only condition is that respondents must be prepared to pay the fines, costs, and fees associated with the case in full and the Court will suspend the late fees associated with the file.
