### **SUPREME COURT, COURT OF APPEALS ANNOUNCE FURLOUGH SCHEDULE**

LANSING, MI, May 20, 2009 – Employees of the Michigan Supreme Court, the Court of Appeals, and the State Court Administrative Office (SCAO) will take six mandatory furlough days before the end of the current fiscal year, following the same furlough schedule as executive branch workers.

Accordingly, the Supreme Court, Court of Appeals, and SCAO will be closed on:

- Friday, June 19
- Monday, July 6
- Friday, July 24
- Friday, August 7
- Friday, August 21
- Friday, September 4

The Supreme Court Clerk's Office and the Court of Appeals Clerk's Office will be closed, and so will not be accepting filings, on the state furlough days. For purposes of filing deadlines, furlough days will be treated as if they were court holidays – that is, if a filing is due on a furlough day, it will be accepted as timely if received on the next regular business day.
