show past and prospective jurors that their contributions are greatly appreciated by the court. A member of the bench greets the jurors daily and thanks them for serving.

"Jury service is a vital aspect of our government," said Judge Atkins. "When you serve as juror you not only serve your country, but you serve as an integral part of the justice system."

Atkins added that the 36th District Court has developed ways to enhance the experience of jury duty in the court such as applying closed captioning to the court's "Jurors in Paradise" video. The video is shown to jurors daily and provides an overview of the role as a juror. The closed captioning has been added to serve the hearing impaired community.

"We want every juror to feel appreciated and to know how much we value their time and commitment to our system of justice," Atkins said. "We would also like to thank the many private companies, government agencies, small businesses, school districts, and all those who encourage and support their employees when they are called to jury service.
