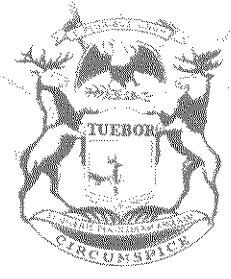

Michigan Law Day 2007


The Michigan Supreme Court acknowledges that Law Day is a celebration of our nation's great heritage of liberty, justice, and equality under law; and,

All youth need to understand their rights and responsibilities under the law to become effective participants in our nation's civic life; and,


