### **CHILD SUPPORT LEADERSHIP COUNCIL APPOINTMENTS MADE BY MICHIGAN SUPREME COURT**

LANSING, MI, June 12, 2007 – The Michigan Supreme Court today announced its recent appointments to the Child Support Leadership Council, which advises the Governor and the Court on child support issues.

The Child Support Leadership Council is comprised of nine community leaders with expertise in child support. Of the nine council members, the Governor and the Supreme Court each appoint four members to the council and jointly appoint one member.

The Court's appointees include:

John Lazet of Mason, chief of staff for state Senator Alan Cropsey. He will serve a term expiring on April 11, 2008.

Hon. Lita M. Popke of Canton, presiding judge of the Wayne County Circuit Court Family Division. She is reappointed for a term expiring April 11, 2009.

Daniel J. Wright of Grand Ledge, director of the Family Services division of the State Court Administrative Office. He is reappointed for a term expiring April 11, 2009.

The Court also reappointed Michael J. Day of Plainwell, a past president of the Friend of the Court Association of Michigan, to continue serving as cochairperson of the council until January 31, 2008. Day is the Allegan County Circuit Court Administrator and the Allegan County Friend of the Court.
