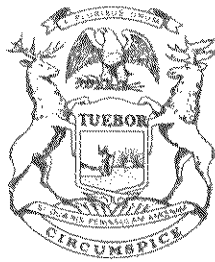

Oral argument in St. Joseph County *Roberts v Saffell*

The goal of the Court Community Connections program is to help educate the public, particularly high school students, about the Michigan justice system, especially the Michigan Supreme Court; and,






