The Michigan Supreme Court is looking for qualified applicants seeking appointment to the State Bar of Michigan Board of Commissioners (SBM-BOC). There are three vacancies this year. In addition to 20 elected members, the SBM-BOC consists of five members appointed by the Michigan Supreme Court. Commissioners serve a three-year term commencing upon the adjournment of the meeting of the outgoing Board of Commissioners held at the annual meeting following the member's appointment. MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

EDUCATION: Juris Doctor (JD) from an accredited law school and a member of the State Bar of Michigan.

2. What experience do you have that makes you qualified for this appointment?
