For all the reasons stated by our Court of Appeals in an opinion issued today, see *Kennedy v Secretary of State*, unpublished per curiam opinion of the Court of Appeals, issued September 6, 2024 (Docket No. 372349), on remand, IT IS ORDERED that Plaintiff Robert F. Kennedy, Jr., is hereby awarded mandamus relief directing the Secretary of State to remove plaintiff's name from the ballot for the November 2024 general election as a candidate for President of the United States.
