Rule 3.305 Mandamus

- (A) Jurisdiction.
 - (1) <u>Unless the constitution, a statute, or court rule requires aAn action for mandamus against a state officer to be brought in the Supreme Court, the action mustmay</u> be brought in the Court of Appeals or the Court of Claims.
