Final Matters Before Releasing the Jury to Deliberate Checklist¹

□ Review the verdict form with jurors; inquire if they have any questions regarding the form or the instructions they received. MCR 2.513(N)(2).
□ Inquire if the parties and counsel are satisfied with the jury instructions. *People v Kowalski*, 489 Mich 488, 504-505 (2011).
□ Unless it is otherwise agreed to, allow the alternate(s) to deliberate, have the clerk draw to select the alternate(s); thank the alternate(s) and instruct that they may not discuss the case until the jury is discharged. MCR 2.511(B).
□ Swear in the bailiff/clerk to safekeep the jurors during deliberations.
□ Release the jury to deliberate with a written copy of the final instructions. MCR 2.513(N)(3).
