On order of the Court, notice of the proposed changes and an opportunity for comment in writing and at a public hearing having been provided, and consideration having been given to the comments received, the following amendment of Rule 3.7 of the Michigan Rules of Professional Conduct is adopted, effective January 1, 2025.

Rule 3.7. Lawyer as Witness.

(a)-(b) [Unchanged.]

(c) Nothing in this rule prohibits a lawyer from appearing as attorney of record in a case in which the lawyer is a party and is representing themselves.

[Official comment unchanged.]

Staff Comment (ADM File No. 2022-56): The amendment of MRPC 3.7 clarifies that in accordance with Const 1963, art 1, § 13, a lawyer can appear in pro per.
