Amendment of Rule 2.002 of the Michigan Court Rules

On order of the Court, notice of the proposed changes and an opportunity for comment in writing and at a public hearing having been provided, and consideration having been given to the comments received, the following amendment of Rule 2.002 of the Michigan Court Rules is adopted, effective January 1, 2025.

Rule 2.002 Waiver of Fees for Indigent Persons

- (A) Applicability and Scope.
 - (1) [Unchanged.]
 - (2) Except as provided in subrule (I), for the purpose of this rule "fees" applies only to fees required by MCL 600.857, <u>MCL 600.878</u>, MCL 600.880, MCL 600.880a, MCL 600.880b, MCL 600.880c, MCL 600.1027, MCL 600.1986, MCL 600.2529, MCL 600.5756, MCL 600.8371, MCL 600.8420, MCL 700.2517, MCL 700.5104, and MCL 722.717.

(3)-(6) [Unchanged.]

(B)-(L) [Unchanged.]

Staff Comment (ADM File No. 2016-10): The amendment of MCR 2.002 clarifies that fees charged for transcripts in probate cases are waivable under the rule as authorized in MCL 600.880d.
