If your court is accepting filings via e-mail in response to the pandemic and the Michigan Supreme Court's AO No. 2020-19, Michigan Legal Help would like to hear from you. Michigan Legal Help hosts its Do-It-Yourself court forms on Pro Bono Net's LawHelp Interactive (LHI) website. A new feature allows users to e-mail their completed forms (with e-signatures, if selected) directly to their court from the LHI website until MiFILE is implemented in your court. This feature includes the ability to send uploaded documents along with the forms.
