 - b. any health-care coverage that is available to them as a benefit of employment or that is maintained by them, the names of the insurance companies, health-care organizations, or health-maintenance organizations; the policy, certificate, or contract numbers; and the names and birth dates of the persons for whose benefit they maintain health-care coverage under the policies, certificates, or contracts; and
 - c. their current residencea, mailing addresses, and telephone numbers.
