**Notice to Juvenile:** You have the following rights:

- to be present at the hearing;
- to be represented by an attorney at the hearing. If you desire to employ an attorney, you should do so immediately in order that s/he may be ready at the hearing date. If you are financially unable to employ an attorney and you want an attorney, your parent must notify the court immediately upon receipt of this notice. If you have a court appointed attorney, you and your parent may be required to reimburse the court in whole or in part for the cost of such services.
- the right to have the petitioner prove the probation violation by a preponderance of the evidence;
- the right to have the court order any witnesses to appear at the hearing;
- the right to question witnesses against you; and
- the right to testify at the hearing if you want to testify.

If you require special accommodations to use the court because of a disability or if you require a foreign language interpreter to help you to fully participate in court proceedings, please contact the court immediately to make arrangements.
