Description: Michigan Public Acts 8 & 9 of 2020 create new procedures and requirements to place children into qualified residential placements, including new judicial findings that must be made to allow a foster care case to receive federal title IV-E funding. The statutory changes are consistent with the federal Family First Prevention Services Act, which aims to reduce childrens' unnecessary placement in residential facilities in favor of more family-like settings.
