Since 1990, the Community Dispute Resolution Program (CDRP) has functioned as a network of nonprofit organizations that receive grant funding from the State Court Administrative Office (SCAO) to provide Michigan citizens with a means to work out disputes outside of court. With over 17,000 hours of mediation, training, and other types of volunteer services in 2017 (representing a market value contribution of \$2.5 million dollars), CDRP is devoted to serving Michigan communities.
