Re: New Account Numbers for Electronic Filing System Fees and DNA Assessments

Date: May 11, 2016

2015 PA 232 (MCL 600.1989) provides that the electronic filing system (EFS) fees collected by a court shall be remitted to the state treasurer to be deposited in the judicial electronic filing fund (JEFF). **The Treasury account number for the JEFF (MCL 600.176) is 228.56.**

2014 PA 457 (MCL 28.176) provides that 25 percent of the DNA assessments collected by a court shall be distributed to the county sheriff or other investigating law enforcement agency that collected the DNA sample as designated by the court to defray the costs of collecting DNA samples. If the state police is the law enforcement agency that collected the DNA sample, 25 percent of the DNA assessment collected should be remitted to the state treasurer. **The Treasury account number for the DNA assessment due to state police (MCL 28.176) is 228.55.**

Treasury has revised the Fee Transmittals for State of Michigan Courts (Treasury forms [57](#) and [295](#)) and can now receive and accept JEFF and DNA assessment revenue. On the next transmittal to the state of Michigan, please remit to Treasury all EFS fees and DNA assessments using the appropriate account numbers noted above. For example, if your court has not yet transmitted funds for April, on the April transmittal, which is due by May 20, 2016, the court can transmit all fees and assessments collected, but not yet remitted, through April 2016. If your court has already transmitted funds for April, on the May transmittal, which is due by June 20, 2016, the court will transmit all fees and assessments collected, but not yet remitted, through May 2016.

Treasury has notified local funding units of the revised transmittals and account numbers by sending an e-mail on a local government listserv.
