RE: Permanency Indicators Reports – Update for TCS Courts

Last month, I announced that the State Court Administrative Office (SCAO) is working to improve the Court Improvement Program (CIP) reports available through the Judicial Data Warehouse (JDW). These reports summarize timeliness in court processing of child welfare cases. I also announced that courts that submit to the JDW the necessary data elements for these reports would no longer be required to submit the Permanency Indicators Report (PIR).

At this time, courts in the following counties that use a case management system offered by Judicial Information Services (JIS) are no longer required to submit the PIR.
