In Person Filing Options

Starting on Monday, **June 15, 2020**, the Court of Appeals clerk's offices will be open to the public. Please phone your local Clerk's office in advance of your visit to make an appointment. We would like to control the number of visitors in the office at the same time to minimize everyone's possible exposure to the coronavirus.

For an **in-person office visit**, you will be asked to:

- Fill out a health screening form upon entering the office.
- Follow certain safety protocols at all times while in the office.
