

Michigan Board of Law Examiners Bar Examination Security Policy
Remote Bar Exam - July 28, 2020

Applicants are not permitted to have at their work stations any items other than a clear bottle of water with the label removed or a clear glass of water.

For further clarification, while no items other than water are allowed, the following items are strictly prohibited and will not be permitted in the work station:

Hats, hoods or any other headgear (except items of religious apparel). **If wearing a hooded sweatshirt or a “hoodie”, the hood must remain down at all times.**
Electronic devices such as cell phones, calculators, pagers, cameras, radios, recording devices, hand-held computers, iPods, any type of personal digital assistant, fitness trackers, any type of wireless e-mail or communication devices, etc.

Watches and timepieces of any type are strictly prohibited. The voluntary practice exam will instruct applicants on how to set timers within the testing modules.

Handbags or purses

Backpacks, Duffle bags, Briefcases, Tote bags

Laptop cases

Notes

Scratch paper

Books, magazines, newspapers or any other reading material

Bar review or other study material in any format or media

Ear plugs, headphones or headsets

Imaging devices

Food (unless you have a medical condition and *prior* arrangements for accommodation have been made)

Medications (unless you have a medical condition and *prior* arrangements for accommodation have been made)

Applicants are required to remain their seats with their face in view of their computer camera during the entire testing module. Failure to remain on camera will result in a voided score for that module and may raise cheating concerns. When testing, applicants will not see the view from the camera and may want to practice using Zoom or another similar application to ensure you are in view.

Unless testing with accommodations and *prior* arrangements have been made with the Board, possession of a prohibited device or item in the examination work area will be treated as a cheating incident and your score for that testing module will be voided.

Applicants must take the exam in a room by themselves. No other person may enter the room during testing. The exam is closed book. No outside information in any form may be accessed to assist you.

The exam upload deadline has been set for Wednesday, July 29, 2020 at 5 p.m. ExamSoft's support number for assistance before, during and after the exam is 866-429-8889 ext. 1.
