

The Court orders that the motion for immediate consideration is GRANTED.

The emergency motion to enforce judgment is also GRANTED. The trial court is ORDERED to immediately sign and enter a preliminary injunction order in accordance with the proposed preliminary injunction order presented by plaintiff-appellant. The body of the preliminary injunction order entered by the trial court shall include *verbatim* the language of the proposed preliminary injunction order submitted by plaintiff-appellant.

This order has immediate effect. See MCR 7.215(F)(2). We continue to retain jurisdiction to verify immediate entry of the preliminary injunction by the trial court.
