The leader will need to be able to attend the award ceremony during Reunification Day at the Hall of Justice in downtown Lansing on June 20, 2019. We invite you to write a letter of nomination in support of a leader detailing his or her passion and efforts toward reunification.

Please describe how the nominee meets the following criteria:

- Describe the leader's philosophy in working towards reunification.
- What skills or innovations has the leader used to help guide the reunification process?
- How does the leader go above and beyond expectations to serve families?
- How has the leader partnered with service providers to ensure the needs of families are being met to promote successful reunification?
- How has the leader promoted reunification among peers and within the community?
- "Leader" can be a jurist, attorney, legislator, DHHS director, private agency director or policy maker.
