Alpena Justice for All Town Hall Meeting with Justice Brian K. Zahra is Cancelled

LANSING, MI, March 17, 2020 - In order to avoid additional risk of exposure to COVID-19, the planned March 25 Justice for All Task Force town hall at Alpena Community College has been cancelled. The Task Force invites local residents to provide comments in writing to justiceforall@courts.mi.gov and Justice Brian Zahra hopes to visit the area later in the year. “While the work of the Justice for All Task Force remains a priority, protecting public health is our top priority right now,” said Justice Brian Zahra, who represents the Supreme Court on the Task Force. “We look forward to hearing more about the civil justice gap in person from residents across the state once public health experts tell us we can do so safely.

Justice Zahra will also be unable to visit the 88th District Drug Court in Alpena on March 26 for their planned graduation ceremony.

“Honoring graduates of Michigan problem-solving courts has long been a priority of the Supreme Court, and we wish the latest graduates of Judge Thomas LaCross’s exemplary program all the best as they begin their new lives,” said Justice Zahra. “We are proud of the graduates and proud of the court and their outstanding team.”
