#### **Michigan Supreme Court Goes on the Road to Traverse City Central High School Community Connections Program Celebrates 25<sup>th</sup> Event**

- What:** The Michigan Supreme Court will hear oral argument in *Maniaci v Diroff*, Supreme Court Case No. 158005. Participating schools include: Traverse City Central High School, Traverse City West Senior High School, and St. Francis High School. A debriefing session with attorneys will follow oral argument.

- Why:** While the Court normally hears oral argument at the Michigan Hall of Justice in Lansing, justices and staff travel to various communities as part of “Court Community Connections,” which the Supreme Court started as a public education program aimed principally at high school students. The event is celebrated as being the Court’s 25<sup>th</sup> such program.
