Schmucker to Receive ABA's Robert B. Yegge Award

LANSING, MI, July 6, 2018 – The American Bar Association announced recently that former State Court Administrator Chad Schmucker is the 2018 recipient of the Robert B. Yegge Award for Outstanding Contribution in the Field of Judicial Administration.

The award will be presented at the ABA's Judicial Division Town Hall Meeting in Chicago on August 4, 2018.

According to the ABA's website, the Robert B. Yegge Award is granted each year "to the person who best emulates the many outstanding contributions to the field of judicial administration. The award honors Robert B. Yegge, former Dean Emeritus of the University of Denver Sturm College of Law and former Chair of the Lawyers Conference (1987-88)."

Schmucker, a former Jackson County Circuit Court judge, served as State Court Administrator from 2011 to 2013 before leaving to become President of The National Judicial College.
