The data presentations will focus on Michigan arrest practices, jail admission and population trends, the prevalence of mental health and substance abuse among inmates, and case processing information to help determine who is in Michigan jails, for how long, and why. recommendations that reduce incarceration trends, promote public safety, and safeguard civil rights.
