Who: Michigan Supreme Court to hear oral argument in insurance case in Kalamazoo
[Case # 147483 - Tienda v Integon National Insurance](#)

What: High school students from 14 area schools (see list below) to study case with attorney mentors, attend oral argument, participate in debriefing session with counsel for parties, meet Supreme Court justices as part of “Court Community Connections” program. More than 4000 students have participated in this program since 2007.
