Who: Michigan Supreme Court to hear oral argument in Macomb County in [PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN v SHAWQUANDA BOROM](#)

What: Students from Macomb County high schools study selected case with attorney mentors, attend oral argument, participate in debriefing session with counsel for parties, meet Supreme Court justices as part of "Court Community Connections" program. This is the 15th time the Court has heard oral argument outside Lansing. To date, more than 4,000 high school students have had front-row seats to study and observe Michigan's highest court.

Prior to oral argument, Chief Justice Robert P. Young, Jr. and Justice David F. Viviano, a resident of Macomb County, will meet with government classes at Chippewa High School.
