Michigan Supreme Court Goes on the Road to Muskegon

WHO: Over 700 students from Reeths-Puffer High School and 12 local high schools
Michigan Supreme Court Justices
Muskegon Circuit, District, and Probate Court Judges

WHAT: The Michigan Supreme Court will hear oral argument in [People v Mead](#).
Participating schools include: Reeths-Puffer, Fruitport, Mona Shores, Montague, Muskegon, Muskegon Catholic, Muskegon ISD/CTC, Muskegon Heights, North Muskegon, Oakridge, Orchard View, Western Michigan Christian, and Whitehall. A debriefing session with attorneys will follow oral argument.

WHEN: October 24, 2018
Oral Argument: 10:00-10:30 a.m.
Student Debriefing: 10:30-11:00 a.m.

WHERE: Reeths-Puffer High School, 1545 Roberts Road, Muskegon, MI 49445

WHY: While the Supreme Court normally hears oral argument at the Michigan Hall of Justice in Lansing, justices and staff travel to various communities as part of "Court Community Connections," which the Supreme Court started as a public education program aimed principally at high school students.

Michigan Supreme Court Chief Justice Stephen J. Markman said: "The Court hopes that the Community Connections program will introduce students to the role of appellate courts in the legal process, while inspiring them to better understand the contributions of lawyers and judges in furthering our country's rule of law."
