- Who:** Chief Justice Bridget M. McCormack, Michigan Supreme Court

Law school graduates who passed the July 2020 Bar Exam
- What:** Anyone who has been notified by the Michigan Board of Law Examiners that they are eligible to be sworn in is invited to be sworn in at this virtual ceremony by Chief Justice Bridget M. McCormack, upon a motion presented by the State Bar of Michigan President Rob Buchanan.
- When:** Monday, November 30, 2020, 2:00 p.m.
- Where:** Ceremony will be conducted via Zoom and live-streamed for friends and family members at:

- Why:** To become a licensed attorney in Michigan, certified bar passers must be sworn in by the court upon a motion of a licensed attorney. Since current conditions do not allow this ceremony to be held in person, it will be held remotely. This swearing-in follows the first-ever online bar examination in Michigan.
