What: The Michigan Supreme Court will hear oral argument in [People v Stephanie White](#)

When: October 21, 2015 – 12:30 p.m. to 1:30 p.m.

Van Buren and Allegan high schools to attend including students from Allegan, Bangor, Berrien Springs, Bloomingdale, Covert, Decatur, Gobles, Hartford, Lawrence, Lawton, Marcellus, Mattawan, Paw Paw, Saugatuck, South Haven, and Van Buren Intermediate School District. A debriefing session with attorneys will follow oral argument

Why: While the Supreme Court normally hears oral argument at the Michigan Hall of Justice in Lansing, Supreme Court justices and staff travel to various communities as part of “Court Community Connections,” which the Supreme Court started in 2007 as a public education program aimed principally at high school students. The goal is to help students understand the appellate courts and Michigan’s judicial system.
